Both the institutes will join together in organizing training programs for the students on emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.

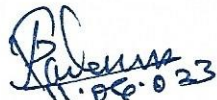
10. Further, we will extend the areas of collaboration for strengthening the academic excellence.**11. Financial commitment:**

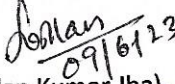
